Board Members present were Pastor Wendy Deichmann, Neal Klopping, Karen Osswald, Cathy Alber, Walker Harris, and Vicki Harris. Also in attendance were Thelma Denlinger and Paula Hoblit. Karen Osswald gave devotions and offered an opening prayer. Meeting minutes from November 18, 2024 were approved as submitted.

- ⇒ Ministry Team: Pastor Wendy stated Wednesday night prayer meeting would continue beginning January 8th. A chili cook-off community meal will be held on Sunday, January 12th following worship service. Pastor Wendy stated new projectors were needed for the sanctuary. 


