

Community Board Highlights


The Community Board met on Monday, February 24th at 7:00 p.m. Below are the highlights from that meeting:

Board Members present were Pastor Wendy Deichmann, Alan Donaldson, Paul Miller, Karen Osswald, Cathy Alber, John Yancik, Paula Hoblit, Thelma Denlinger, Walker Harris and Vicki Harris. Karen had Paul Miller lead us in singing Jesus Loves Me stating it was important to remember how much Jesus loves us all. Karen offered an opening prayer. Meeting minutes from January 19, 2025 were approved as submitted.

Jeff Ginter moved to accept the following proposed positions and the motion was approved with no objections:

- * Co-Chairs of Children's Ministry: Kathy Hubley and Nancy Cera
- Ministry Team: Pastor Wendy reviewed the Ministry Team meeting including the Lent Services collaboration with First UMC and Antioch UMC. Community Potluck meal on March 9th. Please bring a casserole. First and Antioch members will be invited. There is a need for people to volunteer at the school, reading to the children once a week. There is a need for volunteers at Brookhaven to help with activities from 1:00 to 3:00 pm on Wednesdays and Fridays. Women's Breakfast on March 15th at 8:00 am at Rob's. Men's Breakfast on the 1st at 8:00 am at Rob's. There is now a schedule for coverage in the nursery if needed on Sunday mornings. VBS is scheduled for June 23rd through June 27th at Trinity Church. Volunteers are needed.
- ⇒ Pastor Wendy thanked everyone for stepping up to offer their time to be on committees at the church and welcomed the new volunteers. 

Sunday morning Study continues with Jeff Ginter - 9:15 a.m.


