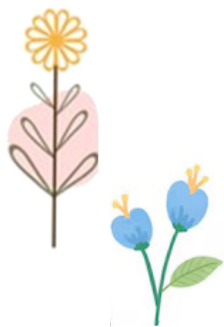

Office hours are limited and response time to emails may vary.

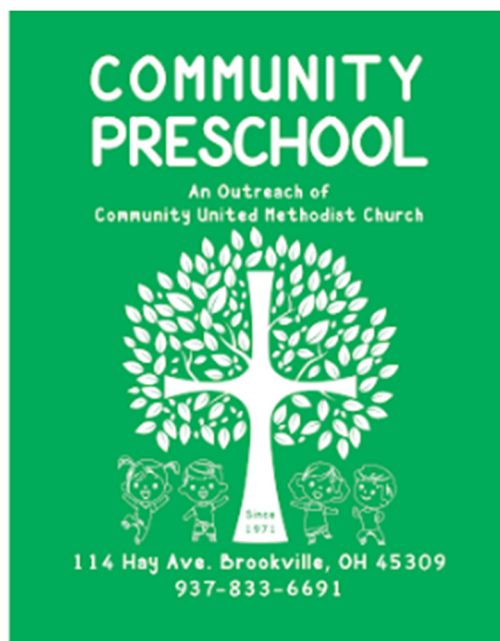
August is the month for the church to show their support for our preschools new school year. Shirts this year will be kelly green.

Community Board Highlights

The Community Board met on Monday, July 21st at 7:00 p.m. Below are the highlights from that meeting:

Board Members present were Pastor Wendy Deichmann, Alan Donaldson, Karen Osswald, John Yancik, Kris Yancik, Jim Weaver, Walker and Vicki Harris. Neal Klopping, Jeff Ginter, Paul Miller, Cathy Alber, Paula Hoblit and Thelma Denlinger were absent. Wendy offered an opening prayer. Meeting minutes from June 16, 2025 were approved as submitted.

- ⇒ **Finance:** John stated LCNB and LPL Financial aided in the transfer of funds from the parsonage money to CD's.
- ⇒ **Trustees:** Wendy reviewed the wedding policy and church use policy. There are still changes that need to be incorporated before completion. The fire alarm system will need inspected. There was a termite inspection and everything checked out just fine. The AED unit needs checked. Alan stated we are on a journey to find out everything that needs done in the church and make sure it is all written down so that the Trustees will have processes and procedures in place going forward.
- ⇒ **SPRC:** Kris stated there was a meeting on July 7th. Barbara Cooper will be extending her contract to help the church with outreach and piano/organ playing 2 Sundays per month. Pastor Wendy will continue with the church for an undetermined amount of time.
- ⇒ **Pastor Wendy welcomed Jim Weaver to the board.** He will be heading up discipleship.
- ⇒ **Ministry Team:** Vicki reviewed the minutes from the July 21st Ministry Team meeting. Wendy stated she had been with the church for almost a year now. God has brought us through a season of grief, healing, faithful leadership and community. It's a new season in the life of the church. Wendy thanked God for all of those in the church and offered her appreciation to everyone who is stepping up to help bring the church forward.
- ⇒ **Office Manager:** Newsletter information is due Thursday, July 24th . Please make sure to get items in for the newsletter and the bulletins by the deadlines so there is plenty of time to get things done properly. The office team will begin the cross-over from Church Windows to an Excel spreadsheet in order to be more efficient with time.
