The Community Board met on Monday, August 25th at 7:00 p.m. Below are the highlights from that meeting:

Board Members present were Pastor Wendy Deichmann, Alan Donaldson, Karen Osswald, John Yancik, Kris Yancik, Jeff Ginter, Paul Miller, Cathy Alber, Paula Hoblit, Thelma Denlinger, Walker and Vicki Harris. Neal Klopping and Jim Weaver were absent. Meeting minutes from July 21, 2025 were approved as submitted.

Paula offered devotions and an opening prayer.

- ⇒ Finance: John stated August was usually the lowest offering month but hopefully September will be a better giving month.
- ⇒ Trustees: Paula stated her and Thelma met with Silco for the fire and alarm protection. There will be a meeting on August 26th with Silco. The Trustees will be doing a walk-through of the church so everyone knows where things are and how to work them. The water fountains have been repaired and the cost for the repairs have been covered by donation. The church use policy and wedding policy are completed. The landscapers will start keeping the weeds down along the fence in the back parking lot.
- ⇒ SPRC: Kris stated the conference has extended Barbara Cooper's contract through January 2026 and Barbara will be with us 2 Sundays per month and will help with outreach.
- ⇒ Pastor Wendy discussed a request from a member of the congregation about rehoming a bookcase that was previously donated to the church but was no longer needed. The board approved the request.
- ⇒ Ministry Team: Vicki reviewed the minutes from the August 25th Ministry Team meeting.
- ⇒ Office Manager: Newsletter information was due Thursday, August 21st but no articles have been received. Please turn in your articles as soon as possible. Vicki will be on vacation from Saturday, August 30th through Sunday, September 7th. Walker will be working his normal office hours of Tuesday and Friday from 8:00 am until 1:00 pm.
