How quickly the seasons change – oh my! I pray this first newsletter of autumn finds each of you blessed by the riches of God's amazing love – the best thing that never changes!

In a recent sermon I shared an ancient prayer method – "breath prayer" - that some have asked me to share again. It is a way of praying that reminds us even the air we breathe and every breath we take into our bodies are gifts from God. When we ponder this fact, we can become more intentional about breathing into ourselves the peace, love, compassion, help, and even the forgiveness God holds for us.

Breath prayers are short – only six to eight syllables usually and each one is repeated several times (at least.) They are offered as we inhale and exhale. For example, while inhaling we might say: "Dear heavenly Father. . . ." or "Most Holy God," or "Precious Jesus;" and while exhaling, "Grant me peace" or "Give me wisdom" or "Forgive me for messing up." Breath prayers can be tailored to exactly who and where you are and according to your personal needs, but you may also pray them on behalf of others. For example, "Great Physician, grant healing to Steven."

It is never presumptuous to pray a prayer to God, since prayer is never our idea. It is God's idea and a gift to us for the purpose of relationship with God. So, go for it and be blessed! Pray, pray, pray without ceasing, as we are instructed in Holy Scripture.



Board Members present were Pastor Wendy Deichmann, Alan Donaldson, Karen Osswald, Paul Miller, Neal Klopping, Jim Weaver, Paula Hoblit, Thelma Denlinger, and Vicki Harris. John Yancik, Kris Yancik, Jeff Ginter, Cathy Alber and Walker Harris were absent. Meeting minutes from August 25, 2025 were approved as submitted.

Thelma offered devotions and an opening prayer.

- ⇒ Finance: Vicki gave a review of the current finances. Giving is still down for September. Hopefully October will be a better giving month along with the rest of the year.
- ⇒ Trustees: Paula stated her and Thelma had spoken to several companies about the doors that were not working correctly. They are working to get them repaired. Paula discussed the girl scout's request to use the church. There was discussion regarding facility usage and the rules that go with it. Paul will create a contract for the girl scouts group to sign which will provide simple guidelines to them for their meetings. 
